

# Drop Lace Scarf

## Yarn and Needles:

I used 2 skeins of aran weight yarn, 212 yds per skein (including fringe), with 10.5 (6.5 mm) needles. Gauge isn't critical, use any yarn and needle size combination you wish, to make any length scarf desired.

## Instructions:

CO 48 sts.

Rows 1-4: K

## Twisted Drop Stitch

Row 5: Wrap and K ea st as follows: Insert right needle into the st as if to knit. Wrap the yarn around the tips of both needles 3 times, then around the tip of the right needle once. Draw the last wrap on the right needle through the 3 wrapped loops and the st on the left needle, dropping the loops and st from the left needle.

Row 6: This row is easier to work before pulling to drop all the wraps. Pull the first st, to judge how much slack is needed on the working yarn to match the drop of the st. (YO, K2tog) 24 times.

## Lace Section or see chart

Row 7: K4, (K2, YO, SK2P, YO, K3) 5 times, K4

Rows 8, 10, 12, 14: K4, P40, K4

Rows 9, 11: K4, (K2tog, YO, K3, YO, SSK, K1) 5 times, K4

Row 13: Repeat Row 7

Repeat rows 5-13 until desired length, repeat rows 5-6, and knit 4 rows. Bind off. Secure ends and add fringe, using 6-8" lengths of yarn.
